BRANT CHRISTIAN SCHOOL SOCIETY STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe that our Statement of Faith forms the basis for sound Biblical instruction.

1. We believe the 66 Canonical Books of the Protestant Bible to be the inspired and only infallible authoritative written Word of God.
II Timothy 3:16,17.
2. We believe that there is one God eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Matthew 28: 19, II Corinthians 13: 14.
3. We believe that the universe originated by the creative act of God as revealed in Holy Scriptures, and that the form of every kind of life was fixed at the time of its creation. Genesis 1: 1, John 1:1.
4. We believe in the true deity and true humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ, His pre-existence, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and His future visible return in power and glory. Colossians 1: 13 – 20, John 1: 14.
5. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is the only mediator between God and man. 1 Timothy 2:5.
6. We believe that all men are lost and sinful, and that salvation is received by personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and by the act of regeneration of life by the Holy Spirit of God. Romans 3: 23 – 26, Titus 3: 5.
7. We believe that by the present indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit, the Christian is enabled to live a godly life, and that every believer should practice the holiness which God requires. Ephesians 1: 13 – 14, Romans 8: 1 – 4, Romans 12: 1 – 2, Titus 2: 11 – 13.
8. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: they that are saved unto the resurrection of life; and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. John 5: 25, 28 – 29.
9. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ. John 17: 23, I Corinthians 12: 12 – 13.
10. We believe that, individually and corporately, we are called to the task of sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ to people of all languages and nationalities with a view to their salvation. (Matt. 28: 19,20; Acts 2:39; 2 Cor. 5:20; 2 Tim. 4:5)

We recognize that there are other interpretations, convictions, and doctrines professed by Christians, which they believe to be consistent with the above. However, such beliefs shall not be promoted by Brant Christian School, though they may be respectfully discussed.
